A group of young Republican community leaders in Fauquier County are forming an official Young Republicans club to help foster the principles of individual liberty, limited government, free market economics, traditional values and a strong national defense among the community while working to elect conservative Republicans to office in Virginia.

Important to the growth of the Republican Party, the Young Republicans (YRs) reach out to registered voters, 18 to 40 years of age, and provide them with better political knowledge and understanding of the issues of the day. Through community involvement in political issues, charitable projects and participation in political campaigns, YRs work to improve the community, and the world in which we live.

Fauquier County Republican Committee associate member Adam Cassandra is leading the formation of the Fauquier County Young Republicans (FCYRs) with the support of Republican leaders in the county. Mr. Cassandra is the former Maryland state chairman of the young conservative activist organization Young Americans for Freedom, and is an editor of the group's official magazine The New Guard.
