Traveling Players Ensemble trains middle and high school students in classical theatre performances. Selected as a "Summer School in the Arts" by the National Endowment for the Arts, Traveling Players has performed at The Kennedy Center's Millennium Stage, Wolf Trap's International Children's Festival and Colonial Williamsburg.
