In the spring of 1977, founders Shelly Lotter and Leslie Lipton broke through the gender boundary following Yale's admission of women, bringing together some of the best male and female voices Yale's campus had to offer. The result was Redhot & Blue, Yale's first co-educational a cappella group. Redhot & Blue has earned national recognition for its unique brand of vocal jazz, winning CASA awards for best arrangement, best soloist, and best album. Though rooted in jazz, Redhot & Blue's repertoire is extensive and varied; our arrangements are inspired by everything from the scats of Ella Fitzgerald to the rhythms of calypso to the modern melodies of '90s bands. Whatever the genre, Redhot & Blue is known for its unfailing commitment to the highest musical standards.
